### **Local Legislators Announce Continuation Grant For Warren Elementary School**

**BOSTON – Senator Anne M. Gobi (D-Spencer) and Representative Todd M. Smola (R-Warren, Ranking Member, Committee on Ways & Means)** are pleased to announce that the Quaboag Regional School District has been awarded \$114,840 as part of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers (CCLC) Grant Program. The CCLC is supported with federal funds and is administered through the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education.
